Summary

- Population increased from 10.12.0 specimens in 2005 to 28.20.0 specimens on 31.12.2008 because of the good breeding results from Arnhem and Berlin Tierpark.
- The surplus of males could cause problems in the future.
- Negative is the failure of breeding in Frankfurt, Villars Dombes and Walsrode and the total loss of birds by unknown causes in Leipzig.
