The positions will report to the Director of Operations and will be responsible for the development and management of the bird and lower vertebrate & invertebrate collections respectively.

With the Trust's strategic goals in mind, the post-holders will review and progress the animal collection plan; design and develop new exhibits; manage staff and resources efficiently; and expand the zoo's conservation and research activities in the UK and overseas. The zoo has a teamwork culture and, by their nature, the roles will require a 'hands-on' approach.
