Leads research and foster partnerships that achieve an increased knowledge of animal/bird behaviors and care.

Responsibilities:

- Develop strategies, provide direction and set operating objectives for veterinary care, conservation and research projects participation
- Ensure the smooth and efficient running of the Zoology and Avian departments
- Continuously introduce improvements to animal/bird husbandry, enclosures and in the design of new enclosures
- Spearhead efforts by the department in making significant contributions to wildlife research and conservation of endangered species
