NATIONAL PARK PLITVICE LAKES



Plitvice Lakes is the oldest and largest National park in the Republic of Croatia. The park is situated in the mountainous region of Croatia and its 300 km² area is listed on UNESCO World Heritage List. The park is primarily covered in forest vegetation, with smaller areas under grasslands. The most attractive part of the park – the lakes system is product of specific geological substrate and characteristic hydrogeological conditions.

This sightseeing is circular, and includes a walk through the limestone canyon of the “Lower Lakes”, an electric-boat ride across the largest of the Plitvice lakes – Lake “Kozjak”, a panoramic train ride, and a walk along the top of the canyon’s east side all the way back to starting point. You will also see the impressive “Great Waterfall” and the “Sastavci” waterfalls, the beautiful dark blue lakes of “Novakovića Brod”, “Kaluđerovac”, “Gavanovac” and “Milanovac”, as well as the vastness of Lake Kozjak.

AQUATIKA – freshwater aquarium Karlovac is a tourist attraction based on the bio-diversity of Karlovac rivers and lakes and the rich tradition of life on the rivers Kupa, Korana, Mrežnica and Dobra.

Of the about 140 fish species inhabiting Croatia’s rivers and lakes, there are about 50 endemic species. On this tour you will be able to enjoy seeing them.
