Jersey Zoo Internships - July 2022-September 2023

Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust is delighted to be able to offer a number of training Internships at Jersey Zoo, which are designed primarily for university-level or early career conservationists wishing to develop their practical "hands on" skills.

Jersey Zoo is a world-renowned Zoo focused on the breeding, care and conservation of some of the most threatened species. An Internship at Durrell will provide valuable experience to add to your CV, showing future employers that you are committed to a career in the conservation sector.



Where can I train?

There are opportunities to develop your skills in the mammal, bird, herpetology and Zoo education departments or on our red-billed cough reintroduction project. As well as hands on experience all interns will benefit from monthly lectures given by expert staff from different parts of the organisation. There is also an opportunity to carry out research projects, if this is a requirement of your sandwich or industry placement.

How long can I train?

We offer the Internships of 6 -12 months in length. Students attending a 6–7-month placement, can determine if they want to work on 2 departments or specialize in one area. Interns on placements of 8 months and longer will automatically be placed on two departments. There is flexibility on start dates, although 12-month placements will have to start in August/September 2022.

A full uniform, lunch pass and bus travel are available to all Interns, but the intern must be prepared to cover all other costs including travel and accommodation.
